**MALNUTRITION IN THE WORLD**  
Today, there are 800,000,000 hungry people in the world and 20,000,000 of them die every year. They mainly are in Africa (Somalia, Sudan, Eritrea, etc.) and in Asia. Hunger is due to: Poverty, Natural disasters (such as drought, flood), Wars, Diseases (like malaria, Ebola, AIDS). The problem is that these people don't get enough minerals and vitamins. It concerns old people, pregnant women and young children. Malnourished mothers give birth to malnourished babies, creating a cycle that continues for generations. If children are not cured before two years of life, the damage done to their physical growth is irreversible. It is less expensive to prevent malnutrition than to treat malnourished children.
